

## Fold Spear Instructions

Thank you for choosing **Subsea Sports** for your next Lionfish and small game expedition. If you are not familiar with Lionfish harvesting or spearfishing in general we strongly encourage you to seek training from your favorite dive shop **before** use.

The Fold Spear consists of five sections that are connected by shock cord. Connection pieces are designed to have a snug fit so when deploying the pole it may be necessary to complete each insertion **by hand**. *Do not use until all segments are fully seated.*

The head of the spear is made from stainless steel and has 6mm x 1/2" male threads to pair with commonly available tips. The remaining sections are aircraft grade (7075 T9) aluminum alloy.

When using the supplied thigh holster, **you must use the provided tip protector to prevent damage to the holster and more importantly, BODILY HARM TO YOU OR OTHER DIVERS**. The tip cover has a hook that is connected by shock cord. The hook hangs on the inside of the stainless steel head.

Deploying the spear:

1. Hold folded spear in one hand
2. Remove the tip cover assembly by dislodging the hook portion
3. then remove the tip cover
4. Use the provided clip to attach to a D ring on your person (weight belt, BCD etc)
5. Proceed to assemble the corded sections.

Stowing the spear:

1. Carefully fold the spear and hold in one hand
2. Un-clip the tip protector assembly from your D ring
3. Slip the tip cover over the end of the tip
4. Stretch the hook portion and insert hook on the rim of the stainless head.
5. Once confident that the tip is protected, proceed to slide folded spear into the holster.

*Using the tip protector in the reverse order can break it.*

The holster is designed to connect to 2" strap/webbing at the divers waist and the lower harness to wrap around the lower portion of the thigh. Both have a wide range of adjustment to accommodate most divers.

When finished with use, be sure to rinse all items of assembly and holster thoroughly with fresh water. **Once air dried**, stow assembled to avoid premature wear on the shock cord. The shock cord is user replaceable if required.
