

Travel Polespear Instructions

Thank you for choosing **Subsea Sports** for your next Lionfish expedition. If you are not familiar with Lionfish harvesting or spearfishing in general we strongly encourage you to seek training from your favorite dive shop before use.

Although constructed robustly and simple to assemble, the Travel Polespear must be assembled properly to ensure years of use.

The pole comes in three sections. The ends of the front and mid section of the spear are threaded (female).

- No particular order of assembly is required. If you want to use it as a 3ft pole, assemble all three pole sections and use the longer band provided. If you are going to use it as a 2ft pole for close encounters, skip installing the mid section. Be sure to use and install the shorter band (available for purchase separately).
- Be sure NOT to cross thread when assembling each section. Cross threaded joints render the pole inoperable and are not covered under warranty.
- Once all sections are threaded together, be sure to give each joint a forceful twist to ensure they are locked together correctly. This is easier using your favorite Lionfish gloves. Using gloves will facilitate disassembly when finished with use. Then install your preferred tip and snug it up by hand.
- When finished with use, be sure to rinse each **disassembled** section thoroughly with fresh water. **Once air dried**, stow in the travel tube ready for your next adventure.
- Be sure to use the provided tip cover when stowing it in the travel tube. Using the cover *prevents damage to the bands* and scratching of the pole surface. Putting the tip point down opposite of the end with the band first will ensure the band will not get damaged. If you wish to leave the tip on the front section, simply adjust the tube to next larger extension to fit.
